- Prepare daily safety reports and submit them to the loss prevention department
- Perform safety hazard inspections of construction works, laydown, and living areas
- Conduct safety activities and training for employees, including first aid, safety clothing, and health hazards prevention.
- Understand schedule D and the company's loss prevention policy
- Plan for safe performance using guards, barriers, barricades, warning tapes, and signs
- Ensure workers wear prescribed safety outfits
- Conduct toolbox talks to remind workers of safety rules and regulations
- Check and monitor all necessary equipment and materials used at the site
- Hold safety meetings with supervisors and foremen
- Maintain and implement the company's safety manual and client's safety program
